My mother's grandfather was Cader Willoughby Dozier, who married Emily Murden; their son, Cader Willoughby Dozier, born January 6, 1805, married ~~Patience Murden~~, who was born January 1, 1805, whose father was John Behanier (\*) refined English gentleman.
