

GENEALOGY OF THE HOAR-HOARE FAMILY OF U.S.A.

(Given to Harry Kurtz Hoar, Phila, by his Mother Barbara A. Hurtz Hoar in 1911)

MARGARET HOAR, widow of Wallingford Hoar, of the County of Berks, England, deeded from William Penn, a tract of land of 250 acres, to her son Robert Hoar, in February 1728, who about this time emigrated to America with his wife Sarah* and 7 children. The tract is situated on the Pequa Creek, in what is now Sadsbury Township, (near the Gap) Lancaster County, Penna. They were Quakers and Sadsbury is the old Quaker burying ground. ~~(XX)~~

JOSEPH HOAR, SR. married Margeret Linville, first cousin, Dec. 7, 1786.

JOSEPH HOAR, JR. was born Sept. 8, 1787- seventh day of the week at sunset

WILLIAM HOAR, was born February 3, 1789, third day of the week at 10 PM

SARAH HOAR, was born August 5, 1790, fifth day of the week at 7 A.M.

ADAM HOAR, was born November 7, 1791, the second day of the week at 10 PM

MARY HOAR, was born April 13th 1793, the second day of the week at 8 A.M.

MARGARET HOAR, was born the 27th of Sept, 1795, first day of the week at 1 A.M.

FRANCES HOAR (daughter) was born October 29, 1797 first day of week and 7 A.M.

Record of Deaths

* SARAH HOAR, Mother of Joseph Hoar, Sr. aged ~~nearly~~ 100 years, died May 27th, 1787
Born in March 1687

FRANCES HOAR, daughter of Joseph and Margaret Hoar died May 4, 1802 at 3AM age 5 yrs.

JOSEPH HOAR, Sr. died the 14th of July, 1815 at midnight (age 79)

JOSEPH HOAR, Jr. died Sept 27, 1816 at 6:30 PM (age 29 yrs 3 mo 19 days)

MARY MORGAN, daughter of Joseph and Margaret Hoar, died Dec. 18, 1822 (age 29 yrs)

MARGARET HOAR, widow of Joseph Hoar, Sr. died Dec 18, 1840 (age 84 years)

WILLIAM HOAR, died Sept. 1, 1847 in Urbana, Ohio where he is buried.

MARGARET LINVILLE, daughter of Joseph and Margaret Hoar, died Oct. 3rd, 1885,
(age 90 years and six days)

SARAH HOAR, died Mar 22, 1874, aged 83 years and seven months.

ADAM BYERS HOAR, Born May 24, 1836 Died April 9, 1898 AGED 62 Years.
